First round of Special Accreditation of Non-Governmental Organizations and Other Stakeholders

The first round of special accreditation for stakeholder organizations to participate in the [UN 2023 Water Conference](#) resulted with 440 non-governmental organizations, civil society organizations, academic institutions, scientific community, the private sector and philanthropic organizations having been approved by the United Nations General Assembly to participate as observers in the Conference. The final list was submitted by the President of the General Assembly to all Member States on 24 August (see [here](#)).
